Thames Valley Probation anticipates that a number of staff will take part in planned strike action on Wednesday, November 30, 2011. We won't know the exact number until the morning of the strike but we have made contingency plans to cover all aspects of risk-related work, with public protection as our key focus.

Please note that we regard employees' participation in the strike as part of their membership of public service unions and not against Thames Valley Probation as their employer.

We guarantee to respond to emergencies effectively, but less critical work may take longer. Normal service will resume on Thursday, December 1, 2011.
